Say it with "words" this holiday season! "Words" are an important trend in holiday decorating and with so many scrapbooking supplies and oversized letters to choose from, you'll find lots of fun ideas for creating and decorating with words like "Noel," "Snow," "Joy," and "Believe."

We used 7½" tall wooden letters to spell out "Snow" for this fun holiday decoration. Letters were painted Light Butter-milk, then a stencil and silver paint were used to add a flurry of snowflakes. Shimmer and

sparkle were added to the snowflakes with a silver glitter pen. Mounted on the wall or mantel and trimmed with a garland of greens, this word art is sure to become a seasonal favorite.

Button up your holiday decorating with this cute wall piece. Oversized buttons spell out "Noel." Each button is mounted on a scrapbook paper or fabric background then framed with a small wooden frame that's embellished with coordinating paper. Ribbon ties the frames all together.

Create a bucket of winter fun for a special friend by giving her all the ingredients for a relaxing afternoon and a brighter kitchen. Embellish a red bucket with stickers that spell out "snow," then fill it with a mug and hot chocolate, a pretty towel and hot pad, some candy and your best wishes.



◀ Create a coordinating card featuring the "snow" motif to accompany your gift. Sticker letters peek through squares on the cover to convey a sense of seasonal wonder.
