

Block #3

Cutting Directions:

Dark (this fabric will remain the same in each block): Cut two 4" squares

Light Background (this fabric will remain the same in each block): Cut two 4" squares

Main Floral: Cut two 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

Dark Green: Cut two 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

Red: Cut eight 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

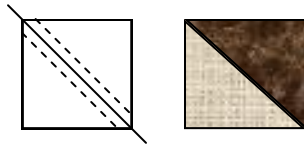
Gold: Cut two 3 7/8" squares.

Red Vine Print: Cut one 3 7/8" square.

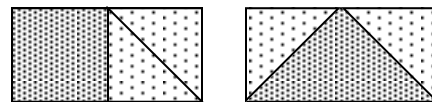
Brown Print: Cut one 3 7/8" square.

Piecing Directions: Flying Goose and Half Square Units (HST)

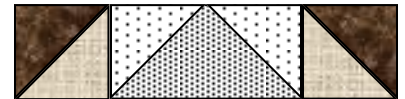
HST: Layer the two dark and two light background 4" squares, RST, draw a diagonal line on the back of the light; sew 1/4" on each side of the line, cut on the line. Press these open to create four HST; square to 3 1/2".



Flying Goose: Place one red 3 1/2" square on one end of each main floral rectangle; draw a diagonal line from the top left corner to the lower right corner; sew on the line. Press to the corner; trim excess from behind. Place a second red 3 1/2" square on the other end of the dark green rectangle; draw a diagonal line from the top right corner to the lower right corner; sew on the line. Press to the corner; trim excess from behind. Make four flying goose units.



Sew one HST to each end of TWO of the flying goose units. Set aside.



Block Center: Layer one gold and one red vine $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square, draw a line on the diagonal, sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side. Cut on the line. Open and press for two half square triangles. Square to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat using one gold and one brown print $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Sew these four HST units together to create the center and square to $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

Sew one flying goose unit (without the HST) on opposite sides of the center unit. Press. Sew the two flying goose units with the HST to the opposing sides of the unit. Square should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
