

# Olde Homestead in Richmond, KY

Olde Homestead in Richmond, Kentucky is a primitive gift shop with country items, antiques, and folk art. As expected, with a name like Olde Homestead, handmade items fill some of the nooks and crannies of this shop. Country furniture, especially Johnston Benchwork's Country Upholstered Furniture, are featured items.

Debbie and David Rogers operate Olde Homestead with the occasional help of their eleven-year-old son, Jason. They opened the store in May, 2006, but are not newcomers to the antique business. For many years, they collected antiques and operated their business

out of rented booths in antique malls. From 1994 to 2006, their love for antiques was shared with others through this means.

When Debbie and David opened Olde Homestead they started with a 750 square foot room. They have since expanded to double that size.
