Block One – Courthouse Steps

Cutting Instructions:

Cream 3" x 7"

Cut (1) - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Red 7" x 7"

Cut (2) - 1½" x 6½" rectangles

Cut (2) - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Rust 3" x 9"

Cut (1) - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Blue 6" x 13"

Cut (1) - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Cut (1) - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Green 3" x 9"

Cut (1) - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Brown 3" x 9"

Cut (1) - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Tan 3" x 13"

Cut (1) - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle


Sewing Instructions:

Use 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.


Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " red rectangle to the long sides of the cream rectangle. Press seams toward the red.




Sew a 1" x 4½" red rectangle to the left and right sides of the block. Press seams away from center.




Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rust rectangle to the top and a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " blue rectangle to the bottom of the block. Press seams away from center.



Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " green rectangle to the left side and a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " brown rectangle to the right side of the block. Press seams away from center.



Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " blue rectangle to the top and a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " tan rectangle to the bottom of the block. Press seams away from center. Square to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Now you have made a signature block to personalize your quilt. This block is also known as a Log Cabin block or Courthouse Steps block.

You can embroider by hand or machine or use a permanent fabric marker to write the year, your name, etc. on this block in lieu of having to make a quilt label.
