April Block-Tulip- 6" finished

Fabric Required:

Fat quarter of light for background Fat quarter pink or red for tulip Fat quarter green for leaves Small scrap of gold or yellow for tulip

Cutting:

If you choose to use Thangles, use the 2.0 size

From the light: (3) 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

(1) 1 ½" X 2 ½"

(1) 1 ½" X 1 ½"

(1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X 5" if using Thangles

OR (2) 27/8" 27/8" cut in half diagonally if using traditional methods

Red: (1) 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

(1) 2 1/2" X 5" for Thangles

OR (1) 27/8" X 27/8" cut in half diagonally if using traditional methods


Green (1) 2 1/2": X 5" for Thangles

OR (1) 27/8" X 27/8" cut in half diagonally if using traditional methods

Gold or Yellow: (1) 1 1/2" X 1 1/2"

Piecing:


1. Lay the 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " light and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow squares right sides together and sew with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam to make a rectangle, press. Pair this rectangle with the light 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and sew to form a square as shown in the diagram.



2.If using Thangles, follow manufacturers directions and make (2) red/ light half square triangles, and (2) green / light half square triangles.

OR for traditional methods, pair the red 27/8° cut triangles with the light 27/8° cut triangles and sew to form(2) half square triangles, repeat with the green 27/8° cut triangles and remaining light 27/8° cut triangles

The block is assembled as a 9-patch as shown in diagram.



Follow general appliqué instructions for umbrella and raindrops

Fabric for appliqué: Small piece for umbrella
Scraps of blue for raindrops
Dark for handle of umbrella
OR
You may use satin stitching for handle
